## Abigail's Amazing Alliteration Race

Alliteration is when you use a bunch of words together that start with the same letter. It's a fancy, fantastic, fun way for storytellers to make something stick in your mind. But it can be tricky to come up with words that start with the same letter!

To play Abigail's Amazing Alliteration Race, follow these steps with one other person.
Step 1: Write all the letters of the alphabet down, leaving space after each one.
Step 2: Choose who will go first and set a timer for 15 seconds.
Step 3: Whoever is going first will need to say two words together that start with the letter "A" before the 15 seconds is up. The words should try to make sense (like, "Abigail's Amazing").

Step 4: Restart the timer. The other person playing needs to add another word that starts with an "A" (like "Abigail's Amazing Alliteration").

Step 5: Now it's the first person's turn! They'll need to add a fourth "A" word. You'll keep going back and forth until one of you can't think of an "A" word to add.

Step 6: Whoever was the last one to think of an " $A$ " word gets their name written down next to the letter "A" on your alphabet list.

Step 7: Repeat steps 2-6, but this time the words need to start with "B". Take turns on who gets to go first, too!

Step 8: When you've played the game all the way to the letter "Z," add up how many letters each name is written next to. The person with the most is the winner!

Hint: This is a fun game to play over several days. For example, maybe after dinner today you and a parent or sibling could play a round for the letter " A ", and then tomorrow after dinner you can play a round for the
 letter "B"—and so on until you've finished. This will give you lots of time each day to be thinking about good words starting with the letter you're playing on!
