Family Project: Serving Those with Disabilities

Joni Eareckson Tada began the ministry Joni and Friends in 1979 to serve those with disabilities. Her work has changed the way the church all over the world sees and cares for people affected by disability. This family project will help you learn about disability and the many ways you can join Joni, her friends, and God in offering friendship and help to those with disabilities. Start by reading Luke 14:21, 23 in the NIV and praying for God to help you be a friend to others in need.

•	Define "disability" together, asking kids to explain "disability" in their own words.
•	Ask kids to stand up and point to each of their different body parts. Discuss how each body
	part can be affected by disabilities. When you reach the head, discuss disabilities that affect memory, thinking, intellectual development and mental health.

•	Make a list of 3 specific disabilities you would like to learn more about through this family
	project (i.e. vision impairment). Fill in one per day for the next 3 days of the project.

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
Day 5: Serving Those with Disabilities




