

C.S. Lewis & Evangelism Discussion Guide

Here are some tips for facilitating a fruitful discussion about C.S. Lewis and Evangelism. You may want to have one host interview Randy on some of the following before opening the conversation up to questions.

1. Start with Randy's background. Why are C.S. Lewis and evangelism both so important to him?
2. Ask about C.S. Lewis' most evangelistic books, like *Mere Christianity*.
3. Ask Randy questions about how other books, like *The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe*, showcase Lewis' passion for evangelism.
4. Consider what evangelism looked like in C.S. Lewis' life beyond book-writing.
5. Discuss some of the practical insights from *Mere Evangelism*, such as:
 - The Necessity of Pre-evangelism
 - Appealing to Clues
 - Honoring Objections
 - Stirring of Uneasiness
 - The Centrality of the Gospel
 - The Value of Imagery
 - The Reality of Opposition
 - The Power of Prayer
 - The Timeliness of Pushback
 - Giving the Call to Respond
