- 5. Discuss some of the practical insights from *Mere Evangelism*, such as:

 - Honoring Objections
 - Stirring of Uneasiness
 - · The Centrality of the Gospel
 - The Value of Imagery
 - The Reality of Opposition
 - · The Power of Prayer
 - · The Timeliness of Pushback
 - Giving the Call to Respond
